## **George D. Sinclair Scholar Award**

**Type of Award:** competitive, non-need based award for \$10,000 tuition scholarship

**Eligibility requirements:** entering (first-year) full-time MDiv student who:

- Is committed to seeking ordination in either the PCA (Presbyterian Church in America) or the OPC (Orthodox Presbyterian Church)
- Has a college GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Subscription to the *Westminster Standards*

**Award period:** First (entering) academic year (08-09) only.

(Upon coming "undercare" of PCA or OPC Presbytery, award recipient will qualify for the George Sinclair Scholarship or Westminster's MDiv Ministry Scholarship, both covering 40% of each year's tuition expenses.)

**Award Requirements:** maintain fulltime status and minimum GPA of 2.5 throughout award period

### **To apply:**

1. Submit a completed application for admission to the MDiv program. (available online at [www.wts.edu](http://www.wts.edu) or in the Admissions Office).
2. Include a letter of reference from a PCA or OPC Ruling or Teaching Elder.
3. Write an essay of no longer than two pages (double spaced, 12 point font, Times New Roman, one inch margins) stating your hopes for ministry in the church as a pastor, teacher, missionary or evangelist in the PCA or OPC.
4. Include your name, phone number, address, and email address with the essay.
5. Sign a Statement of Subscription to the *Westminster Standards* (available online at [www.wts.edu](http://www.wts.edu) or in the Financial Aid Office), using the same pledge that is required of voting faculty members of the Seminary (and re-subscribe annually as long as the applicant receives this award).
6. Submit the above mentioned application materials to the Admissions Office.

**Submission deadline: March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008 (or until scholarship is awarded).**

You will be notified by mail whether or not you have been awarded the scholarship.
