Westminster is **now accepting applications** for the

Mephibosheth Scholarship

Type of Award: Partial-tuition scholarship

Eligibility requirements: Students with physical/sensory disability in any program of study

Award period: One academic year. Award recipient must reapply each academic year*.

Award Requirements: maintain full-time status and minimum GPA of 2.5 throughout award period

To apply:

1. Fill out Westminster Tuition Scholarship Application (available online at www.wts.edu or in the Financial Aid Office).
 2. Specify on the application that you are applying for the Mephibosheth Scholarship.
 3. Write an essay* of no longer than two pages (single spaced, 12 point font, Times New Roman, one inch margins) stating your reasons for choosing Westminster. Include:
 - circumstances affecting your decision to come to seminary
 - your vision for future ministry
 - description of how your current ministry aligns with your vision for future ministry
- *Essay is required only the first time student is applying for award. Award recipient is not required to write essay for subsequent academic years.
4. Include your name, phone number, address, and email address with the essay.
 5. Submit the above mentioned application materials to the Financial Aid Office.
 6. Be available for a possible interview (live/phone) with Scholarship Committee upon request.

Submission deadline: March 31 (or until scholarship has been awarded)

You will be notified by mail whether or not you have been awarded the scholarship.
