



Westminster is **now accepting applications** for the

Texas Campus M.Div. Scholarship

Type of Award: merit-based 40% tuition scholarship

Eligibility requirements: Entering (first-year) full-time MDiv students in a program of study at our Texas Campus in Dallas. Applicants must be U.S. Citizens or permanent residents, and must meet one of the following criteria:

- RUF internship completed or RUF student with RUF Campus Minister recommendation for scholarship
- Documented involvement in and/or commitment to African American, Hispanic, or Korean-American Ministry
- Documented involvement in and/or commitment to International Missions
- Documented involvement in and/or commitment to Church Planting
- Documented involvement in process leading to gospel ministry in a NAPARC church
- Documented potential for significant ministry leadership

Award period: one academic year only. Award recipients must reapply each academic year.

Award Requirements: maintain full-time status and minimum GPA of 2.5 throughout award period

To apply:

2. Fill out Westminster Scholarship Application and FAFSA (available online at www.wts.edu).
3. Write an essay of no longer than two pages (single spaced, 12 point font, Times New Roman, one inch margins) stating your reasons for choosing Westminster. Include:
 - circumstances affecting your decision to come to seminary
 - documented involvement corresponding to the eligibility criteria noted above
 - your vision for future ministry
 - description of how your current ministry aligns with your vision for future ministry
