Westminster Theological Seminary announces an opening in the department of Systematic Theology. This is a full-time, tenure-track position, effective July 1, 2008. Responsibilities will primarily include supervising and teaching at the Ph.D. level. Other responsibilities will include some teaching at the M.Div. and M.A.R. level; they may also include supervising and teaching Apologetics at the Ph.D. level. Applicants should have an earned doctorate in Systematic Theology or a related discipline, show strong evidence of potential for scholarly writing and effective teaching, and be ordained or pursuing ordination in a Reformed or Presbyterian denomination. The candidate's personal commitment to the Westminster Standards and to the Seminary's core values, as set out in its Mission Statement (www.wts.edu/general/mission.html), is also required. All qualified applicants are encouraged to apply. Salary will be commensurate with rank. Applicants should send a copy of their curriculum vitae, including names of two references, to Carl R.
