Download a supported eBook reader:

- Install [Adobe Digital Editions](#) on your computer
- [Register for an Adobe ID \(https://accounts.adobe.com\)](https://accounts.adobe.com) to authorize your reader app(s) and to be able to use eBooks on multiple devices.
- Signup for a free EBSCOHost account on the EBSCO website. You will be prompted to do this when you select an eBook.

You can authorize any combination of up to 6 computers and devices.
